A Day with Dr. Jan van Dijk: Assessment and Communication Strategies

- What:** Dr. Jan van Dijk, a world-renowned educator and researcher in the field of deafblindness, will be presenting a one-day workshop. His presentation will cover the eight domains of the child-guided approach; communication strategies to enhance interaction; strategies to lead the child from idiosyncratic (unique) behavior to symbolic communication; and the role of mirror neurons and how to elicit them (resonance).
- Why:** For over 50 years, Dr. van Dijk has pioneered assessment, communication and teaching approaches for children with combined vision and hearing losses and multiple disabilities. He has helped numerous families and professionals gain a better understanding of their children and how to best reach and educate them.
