The Arts For All adapted library includes paint rollers for mural painting, a print table for printing textiles and paper with participants' designs, wheelchair chalk drawers, paint poles, and many other devices. All of the equipment is designed so that participants with limited movement or fine motor skills can be successful at their own level of ability, creating original works of art. The art activities foster social interaction, self-esteem, and natural inclusion; each child works at their own level of ability.
